

Coldwater loaded with talent at skill positions

COLDWATER — Coming off the 2005 state championship run, the Coldwater Cavaliers went 10-0 during the regular season and won a third straight Midwest Athletic Conference

The Cavaliers rolled through the competition before falling in the regional semifinals to Oak Harbor, ending a 26-game winning streak.

Coldwater still has a 32game regular season winning streak going for them as the 2007 campaign gets underway. The last time the Cavaliers lost in the regular season was in

2003 against Versailles.

John Reed, enshrined in the Ohio High School Football Coaches Hall of Fame this past spring, will need to fill a few spots vacated by graduation, but he has a talented group of seniors and underclassmen to fill the bill.

"Overall, our work ethic has been tremendous: Over our conditioning period and the early part of two-a-days, the attention to detail, the work ethic and not taking things for granted, good leadership and good example setting by our older players," said Reed. "You and I both know that once you have the opportunity to have success, then that success has a

tendency to breed success. Older players know what it takes to play at that level, then they try to pass it on to those other guys. That's the thing that impresses me most so far."

OFFENSE

Junior Cory Klenke (6-1, 181) and sophomore Keith Wenning (6-3, 199) have been taking equal snaps in practice to take over at quarterback for the graduated Sam Slavik.


"They both bring something a little bit different to the table," said Reed. "I know we can be successful with both of those quarterbacks.

"We won't be the same team. Cory brings a different skill level at that position. Keith brings

different skill level at that position. So we'll try to identify ourselves based on that."

The ceiving corps is one of the deepest Reed seen. has Rvan Geier (6-

2, 186, senior), who missed half a season with a shoulder injury, but still had 269 receiving yards last year, Zach Kaup (6-1, 189, junior). Zach Siefring (5-10, 158, junior) and Dusty Rutschilling (5-9, 170, junior) will be just a few




son, that makes the corps even more potent. Mark Steinbrunner (5-11,

185, senior) and Brock Pleiman (6-2, 204, junior) are contending for the tight end spot.

As a sophomore, Tony Harlamert (6-0, 175, junior) proved to be one of the best all-around players in the Grand Lake area. Harlamert was second in the area with 606 receiving yards and four touchdowns, led the Cavs with 667 rushing yards in

addition making an impact on defensive and special team.

Justin Bruns (5-10, 189, senior) and Trent Muhlenkamp (5-6, 145, junior) will also look for playing time in the Cavaliers' multi-purpose tailback rotation. Adam Homan (6-2, 232, junior) and Tyler Kunk (5-10, 186, senior) will handle fullback chores.

The front wall will be the biggest change with most of the group graduated from last season. Guards and centers coach Chip Otten noted that the only absolute is Kyle Ahrens (6-0, 186, senior) at center with Greg Kleinhenz (6-2, 215, senior) backing up

or playing guard.

Kurt Schlarman (6-0, 178, senior), Craig Hibner (6-1, 198, senior), Jeremy Jansen (5-8, 188, senior), Trevor Robbins (6-2, 232, junior) and Alex Dues (5-10, 186, junior) are all batting for the guard spots.

Tackles coach Randy Wright has four players battling for the tackle spots and they include Matt Gruss (6-1, 224, senior), Aaron Gilliand (6-4, 217, junior), Ray Brunswick (6-2, 228, junior) and Craig Homan (6-0, 222, junior).

DEFENSE

Kunk will lead a solid group of players back on the defensive line. Schlarman will move from end to tackle this season with Brunswick and Gruss being among those looking to find a spot. Pleiman, Steinbrunner, Gilliand, Keith Schoenherr (6-2, 199, senior) and Nick Gabel (6-0, 184, senior) will contest for an end spot.

Adam Homan had 114 tackles at one middle linebacker spot in the lineup while outside backer Keith Schoenherr is a veteran that had three sacks last season.

Justin Bruns, who was an outside linebacker last year, moves inside with Kelvin Bruns (5-6. 179, senior) also look-

ing for a spot. Rutschilling, whom Reed described as one of the most versatile players on the roster, will join Nate Bruggeman (5-11, 182, senior) at the outside spots.

The secondary shapes up to be the most solid unit in the area. Klenke (safety) and Harlamert (halfback) each had four interceptions last season with Geier (safety) having three in before the injury. Siefring and Kaup will be among the leaders vying for a cornerback spot giving the Cavaliers plenty of depth.

"It's one of the strengths of our team," said Reed of the secondary. "I think we really feel good about our coverage skills. It remains to be seen how good of tacklers we're going to be, but our defensive perimeter will be the strength of our team."

recording 39 extra points and two field goals for 45 total points.

Two areas that were a concern last season were kickoffs and punting. Schoenherr did kickoffs, but had to give way to de la Rosa.

Geier started last season at punter, but Klenke then took over and earned All-District first team honors on special teams.

With the speedsters the Cavaliers have to work with, Reed should have no problem finding someone to return punts and kicks.

OUTLOOK

While Reed sees his skill positions being the key to the team this season, he knows that it will take a solid line — both sides of the ball — to get the results that are expected year in and year out for the Cavaliers program.

"The question mark of the team will be the development of our offensive and defensive lines," said Reed. "You can ask our kids that right now and they would say the same thing."



Ryan Geier caught touchdowns passes of 21 and 34 yards from second string QB Keith Wenning. Ryan posted 6 catches for 132 on the night. All the offense Coldwater needed was provided in the first half as they led 42-0 at half time. The second half saw extended playing time for second and third string players. Versailles took advantage of that by leaving their starters in and scored two touchdowns on drives lasting 11 and 19 plays, consuming much of the second half clock. Trent Muhlenkamp posted Coldwater's final points on a 1 yard plunge with 13 seconds left to play.

Next up for Coldwater (7-1) are the Ft. Recovery Indians (5-3). The Indians have never defeated the Cavs in 12 tries. Coldwater has outscored the Fort 548-66 for an average margin of 40 points. This could be the last time these two teams meet for a long time. With the MAC re-aligning their schedules next year, these two teams will not meet for at least the next two seasons.

Tony Harlamert again led the Cavs in scoring as he had runs of 2 and 17 yards as well as a 30 pass from Cory Klenke. Klenke also completed a 40 yard pass to Ryan Geier. Adam Homan scored on a run yard plunge and Trent Muhlenkamp scored on a five yard scamper. Trent led all rushers with 92 yards coming of the bench after Coldwater had secured a 38-0 half time lead. Also Mario del la Rosa kicked a 34 yard field goal, his third of the season.

Kudos to the defense as well as the first team not only held the Jays scoreless in the first half but allowed zero net yards as well. For the game the Cav defense allowed only 96 yards and forced five turnovers; 3 fumbles and 2 interceptions.



The 2007 season will continue for the Coldwater Cavaliers as they posted an impressive 43-14 victory over the Jonathan Alder at Volunteer Field in Plain City. For the first time this season the Cavs posted over 500 yards of total offensive; 206 rushing and 326 passing. The Pioneers had 298 yards total but most of that yardage came when the games was already decided.

Coldwater led 14-0 at halftime on the arm of quarterback Cory Klenke as his receivers found holes all over the Alder secondary. Cory had his best night this season going 23 of 39 for 311 yards and two touchdowns; 25 to Justin Bruns and 65 to Tony Harlamert. Klenke also had 90 yards rushing scoring on runs of 2 and 11 yards.

Harlamert added a rushing touchdown from 2 yards as did Trent Muhlenkamp who scored from 3 yards out. Harlamert lead all receivers with 146 yards on 9 catches. Zach Kaup 86 yards on 7 grabs as well.

The defense was stellar was well, limiting Alder QB Austin Schlosser to 7 of 20 passing for 76 yards. Alder was able to garner 222 yards on the ground, but 152 of those yards came late in the game, most of it on a nifty 66 yard TD jaunt by Schlosser. Alder fumbled the ball four times, losing two.

This was the first home loss for Alder in 33 games, dating back to the 2002 home opener when they were defeated by Marion Local. What hurt the Pioneers most was losing their composure as the were cited for 10 penalties netting 110 yards including 4 personal fouls and 2 unsportsmanlike conducts. It is a shame that a team with so much talent can't maintain their composure when things get tough. But so it goes...

As for Coldwater their next opponent is the team most observers see as the team to beat on this side of the state. The Knights of Kettering Alter will face the Cavaliers at Alexander Stadium in Piqua. Alter brings an unblemished record to their first meeting with Coldwater. Last season the Knights played in the Division 3 state championship, losing to the Big Red of Steubenville 34-33.



It was what many have called a game for the ages. In one of he most exciting games played in Ohio this fall the Coldwater Cavaliers twice battled back from 21 point deficits to outlast the highly talented Kettering Alter Knights 59-52 in triple overtime.

Despite having players going both ways it was the Cavaliers that showed more energy thru the fourth quarter and the overtime sessions. The Knights running game ran though the Cav defense for three quarters, posting 360 rushing yards on 65 carries for the game. But following a touchdown with 17 seconds left in the third, Alter could only manage 3 more points. Meanwhile the Coldwater passing game picked apart the Alter defense and scored 24 points to win the contest.

Cory Klenke had the best game of his career complete 25 of his 50 passes for 431 yards and 7 touchdowns. Zach Kaup was Klenke favorite receiver as he caught 10 passes for 190 yard scoring 3 touchdowns. Ryan Geier added 6 clutch receptions for 97 yards and 2 TDs. Tony Harlamert added 6 catches for 82 yards and 2 scores while Zach Siefring had 3 catches for 62 yards. The ground game only managed 55 yards on 12 carries, but that was by design as the game plan was to go over the large Kettering d-line instead of trying to go through it.

Klenke has had the two best games in his career these past two weeks. He has completed 48 of his 89 passes for 742 yards and 9 touchdowns with four interceptions. Cory's performance in this game placed him among the best in the history of Ohio High School football. His 431 yard passing ranks 43rd all time, but his 7 TD passes ranks him at #8 with Ben Mauk of Kenton and one behind Findlay's Big Ben Roethlisberger.

It was the first triple overtime game that Coldwater has participated in. They now stand 6-1 in overtime games. The total points scored in this game (111) set a school record for most combined points scored in a game. The Cavs ran their week 12 record to 9-3 and now stand 28-11 in post season play. The victory also marked win number 140 for Coach John Reed against only 28 defeats while at Coldwater.

Next up for Coldwater is the Region 16 Championship game which will be played at Welcome Stadium in Dayton. Their opponent will be Clarksville Clinton-Massie. The Falcons stand at 11-1, their only loss coming at Washington Courthouse 35-34. They share a common opponent with Coldwater in Jonathan Alder. The Falcons defeated the Pioneers 14-9 in week 10. CM has appeared in six straight playoffs.








With the victory, Coach John Reed's Cavaliers captured their second regional championship in three seasons and moved to the final four for fourth time since 1998.



Coldwater 59, Alter 52 (3OT)

Saturday at Piqua's Alexander Stadium, Coldwater and Kettering Alter played a game that will be replayed across the Miami Valley and Ohio for ages. Down 21-points twice to the undefeated and favored Knights, Coldwater forced overtime and won 59-52 after three extra periods.

It was a game that featured 981 yards in total offense, 15 touchdowns (six from 30 yards or longer), 43 first downs and three overtimes. And after all that, it was decided by one yard.

Kettering Alter's fourth-down pass came up one yard short of a first down, giving Coldwater a stunning — if not improbable — 59-52 victory in a Division IV, Region 16 semifinal on Saturday. The Cavaliers twice trailed by three

touchdowns. They trailed by two TDs five other times. And the only time Coldwater (11-1) led was the final score.

"That's what we try to build our program on, never giving up," said Coldwater coach John Reed. "We're trying to learn lessons in life. Sometimes you're down 21-0 in life. What are you going to do about it? Are you going to bag it and give up? No, you're going to battle away."

Coldwater certainly fought back. Again. And again. And again. But it seemed like every time the Cavaliers got close, the Knights (11-1) answered with a score of their own. That lasted until the fourth quarter and eventually in the third overtime at a rocking Alexander Stadium at Piqua High School.

Behind a versatile running game that saw success straight up the middle against the Cavaliers, the Knights built a 42-21 lead with



7:08 left in the third quarter. That also left plenty of time for Coldwater's quick-strike spread offense to work. Quarterback Cory Klenke guided the Cavs to TDs on their final four drives in regulation. At defensive back, Klenke's fourth-quarter interception set up the Cavs' final TD, an 11-yard pass to Tony Harlamert that forced overtime with 5:55 remaining.

Alter did drive into Coldwater territory with under a minute to go, but punted with 39 seconds left when the drive stalled at Coldwater's 42 yard line.

In the first overtime (which starts on the opponent's 20-yard line), Coldwater threw into the endzone on three of four passes. The Cavs' fourth-down pass from the 17-yard line was on target for Ryan Geier, but an Alter defender knocked the ball away. Alter, needing just a field goal to win, was pushed back by a sack and a tackle for a loss. The Knights' own fourth-down pass from the 36 fell incomplete.

In the second overtime, Alter settled for a 34-yard field goal by Scott Vannatta after two runs and a pass netted three yards. Coldwater was ready to celebrate when Klenke's pass to Harlamert gave the Cavs first-and-goal at the one. But Alter's defense stopped a run by Harlamert, a Klenke sneak, then dropped Harlamert in the backfield. Cavs' kicker Mario de la Rosa booted a 19-yard field goal tie it at 52-52.

In the third overtime, Coldwater converted another first down. On fourth-and-7 from the 17, Klenke — under pressure and with a defender grabbing at his ankles — hit Zach Kaup for 11 yards. Two plays later Klenke threw an over-the-shoulder pass to Harlamert in the corner of the endzone for the 59-52 lead. Alter faced fourth-and-8 on the 18 after a run for two yards and a pair of incompletions. Alter QB Austin Boucher hit Nate Wolfe in the flat, but he was tackled at the 11-yard line to end it.

"There's not a whole lot to tell them other than I was proud of the way they played football, not just tonight but all year," said Alter coach Ed Domsitz, whose team lost to Steubenville 34-33 in the D-III title game last season. "I'm sure everybody is disappointed. (The state championship game) was a goal from the beginning of the year. It was a sad ending tonight."

Alter pounded out 360 yards rushing and 495 yards overall. Roark led the way with 193 yards and 5 TDs on 25 carries. His TDs covered 30, 3, 30, 39 and 10 yards. Chris Borland added 111 yards on 17 carries.

Coldwater, though, slowed down Alter's running game in the second half. The Knights, who scored on their first three possessions, had just one TD over its final four drives. And the Cavs' offense, built to come from behind if needed, did exactly that.

Klenke completed 25-of-50 passes for 431 yards and 7 TDs to a receiving corp that consistently outleaped, outran



and did what it had to get the ball. That included Kaup (10 passes for 190 yards; 3 TDs), Geier (6-97 yards; 2 TDs), Harlamert (6-82 yards; 2 TDs) and Zach Siefring (3-62).

Coldwater ran just 12 times for 55 yards as the passing game accounted for almost all of the Cavs' 486 yards in total offense.

"Our offensive line deserves so much credit. There's no question the guts of No. 11 (Klenke) and our fullback (Harlamert) always blocking and protecting," Reed said. "We played with such tremendous heart tonight. That was one of the greatest games I've been associated with."

Domsitz, though, won't look back on this game in a few years and smile at the thought of playing in a game that many will consider the greatest they ever saw.

"It makes it more difficult to take. You see all the great things we did and it makes it more difficult to accept the fact we didn't win," he said. "I know some people will say this was the greatest game they've ever seen. A great game to me is a game we win, whatever the score."

Mooney & Coldwater set for another clash in Stark County

Hollywood couldn't have authored a better script. "Coldwater-Cardinal Mooney II" debuts Saturday at 3 p.m. in the Division IV state football final at Massillon's Paul Brown Tiger Stadium. The game is a rematch of the 2005 D-IV state final won by Coldwater 33-9. Since then, Mooney has won 28 straight and has a senior class whose record is 52-5. Coldwater's seniors are 52-3. Something has to give Saturday.

PEAK PERFORMANCE: Following a 35-14 Week 2 loss at home to Marion Local that snapped lengthy home and regular season win streaks, Coldwater quietly went about its business.

The Cavs finished the regular season with eight straight wins, but it wasn't until a 59-52 triple-overtime win against Kettering Alter in the regional semifinals that people started to take notice again. Most had Alter penciled as Mooney's eventual opponent.

"We're peaking at the right time," Coldwater coach John Reed said. "We've gotten better and better as the season's gone on. We didn't really know how good we were until we played Kettering Alter and they certainly put us to the ultimate test. We found out then, though, that we can play at the high level that it takes to get to a state championship game. The key is we're playing the best football we can possibly play right now."

Subtract the Alter game from the playoff equation and Coldwater has thrashed its other three postseason opponents 162-42.

CHARGE: The Cavaliers explosive offense is fueled by a slew of junior skill players and the emergence of a solid line.

"I think the thing that has happened is that the offensive line has matured," Reed said. "We didn't have any starters back on the offensive line and when the season started we didn't have the experience it takes to run the offense we run but those young men have matured and remained healthy. We've had some outstanding play from our wide receivers and our quarterback, junior Cory Klenke, has developed along with the offensive line. The maturity and development of the line and quarterback has allowed us to get to the place where we're scoring as many points as we are."

Coldwater has only scored less than 35 points once, and that came in a season-opening 21-7 victory over Kenton.

Klenke has completed 155-of-260 passing attempts for 2,394 yards and 29 TDs. He's tossed 13 interceptions. Klenke is also the team's second leading rusher, having tallied 621 yards and four TDs on 88 carries.

Ryan Geier, Coldwater's lone senior starter among the skill positions, is the Cavs main receiving threat (52 receptions, 994 yards, 11 TDs).

"They are a team that scores a whole bunch of points and racks up a whole bunch of yards rushing and passing," Cardinal Mooney coach PJ Fecko said. "It's an offense that puts up incredible displays of scoring and I don't think you can stop them. You just hope to slow them down."

UTILITY MAN: In addition to the line, receivers and Klenke, Coldwater has also gotten a boost for junior running back Tony Harlamert. Harlamert has 764 yards and 27 TDs on 124 carries and has also logged 756 receiving yards and 10 TDs on 51 receptions. Doubling as a defensive back, Harlamert has eight interceptions.

"I was so pleased to see that he was selected first team (Northwest District) as a utility back because I don't think there could be a better description of him than that," Reed said. "He serves so many purposes. He runs the ball so well, he runs great patterns, he catches the difficult ball, he plays defense and he's an outstanding return person. He's one of those special people."

SIZE DOESN'T MATTER: Coldwater's dominant line play – on both sides of the ball – is somewhat shocking considering the Cavs have no player over 232 pounds on their roster. The starting offensive line goes 186, 198, 232, 224 and 217 pounds. The defensive line is even smaller, weighing in at 199, 204, 186 and 178.

For comparison, Mooney's OL weighs 295, 294, 261, 245 and 287. Its DL is 215, 261, 185 and 266. Mooney linebacker/running back Michael Zordich weighs more (237) than any Cavalier.

"We've been undersized ever since I've been here," Reed said. "We just don't have those big kids. You drive three miles down the road and St. Henry has those guys that are 6-5, 250 and we just don't have those kids. There must be a line of demarcation somewhere in between where they're not allowed to crossover."

Quickness and cohesion are the Cavs strengths.

"Anyone who knows anything about football knows that there needs to be a great cohesiveness among one another on the OL, particularly when you throw the ball as much as we do," Reed said. "You have to have a feel for what the guy next to you is going to do and these guys have that feel. They're not going to blow anyone off the ball, but their tenacity and passion for doing what we do has served itself well."

UNDERDOG: Despite Mooney being the favorite among the masses, Reed said his team hasn't grasped the underdog role or taken kindly to it. The Cavs are immune to such talk.

"Haven't even thought about that," Reed said. "We're just pleased we're playing as well as we are and we're pleased with the opportunity to be playing for a state championship again. I don't think too much about that kind of stuff. That's more for you (media) guys to write about. We're just trying to get ready to play a game."

GETTING TO THE BALL: Coldwater's defense has been overshadowed by its offense, but that unit is noteworthy in its own right. In 14 games, the Cavs have allowed more than 14 points once (to Alter).

Junior linebacker Adam Homan (the younger brother of current Ohio State LB Ross Homan) leads the team with 113 tackles. Senior linebackers Justin Bruns and Mark Steinbrunner are second with 108 tackles each.

Senior tackle Tyler Kunk, a two-time state wrestling qualifier, spearheads the defensive front with 87 tackles, including 15 for loss. Klenke has a team-high nine interceptions.

"They play great team defense and are aggressive," Fecko said. "They bring it every single play and make big plays. They get a ton of people to the ball and haven't really giving anything up to opposing offenses. It's a daunting task for us."

SIMILAR SITUATION: Prior to the 2005 state final, Mooney lost its starting quarterback in the state semifinals and had a fresh face taking snaps against Coldwater. This postseason, the Cards lost their signal caller in the regional semifinals.

Senior Danny McCarthy, one of the state's top players and a threat to win Mr. Football, hurt his neck during the first quarter of Mooney's regional semi victory over Akron St. Vincent-St. Mary and finished the game. The Notre Dame recruit has not played the last two weeks and is likely not going to see action Saturday.

McCarthy rushed for 1,219 yards and 18 TDs on 154 carries this season and threw for an additional 434 yards and five TDs. He doubled as a star defensive back.

"Dan is obviously an outstanding player," Fecko said. "Anytime you lose an athlete and leader of his ability it's never easy to replace. It is a team sport though. There's a lot of other guys on the team."

In McCarthy's absence, senior Tim Marlowe has taken snaps. Marlowe, who has more receptions and receiving yards than pass attempts and yards, has completed 3-of-7 passes for 57 yards and a TD in his two games. He's also rushed for 206 yards and 3 TDs on 25 carries.

STRAIGHT FORWARD: It's no secret that Mooney is going to line up and pound the Cavaliers with its running game. The Cards had two backs over 1,000 yards this year and another with over 900.

"(We do) a little bit of everything," Fecko said. "We spread it around pretty good and have run it a bunch of different ways out of a bunch of different sets. Each game and each week we've taken on a new identity and it's worked well so far. You name a way you can run it and we've done it."

Senior Brandon Beachum, a Penn State recruit, leads the team with 1,569 yards and 17 TDs on 244 attempts, while Zordich, who's also headed to Happy Valley, has 973 yards and 10 TDs on 129 attempts.

SEEING RED: Defensively the Cardinals are led by Zordich and senior Taylor Hill (Oklahoma). Zordich has a team-high 109 tackles and 16 TFL. Hill has 95 tackles and 14 TFL.

Mooney allows 7.9 points per game.

"The pressure they are going to bring," Reed said when asked what concerns him with Mooney's defense. "They are going to pressure us no doubt about that. Their physical play and athleticism is going to be something we have to deal with and whether or not we can contend with that will determine if we can stay in the ballgame or not. If we can't handle their pressure we'll have a hard time."

DIFFERENT BREED: Although a D-IV school, Mooney has made waves nationally this season with an extended stay in many national polls. After watching film, Reed would vote for them too.

"The thing that jumps off the films is their athleticism on both sides of ball," Reed said. "Obviously they have great, great players and they've played against great teams throughout their schedule. They are like so many other teams playing at this point. They don't have to take their game to a different level, they've already played at the level it takes to compete for a state championship."

NOT PLAYING REVENGE CARD: Don't expect Fecko to preach publicly about the 2005 state final and paying the Cavs back for the Cards last lost. That may be a discussion during practice, but not something that the coach sees as important as Xs and Os.

"(Playing Coldwater again in the final) is a unique situation," Fecko said. "(Coldwater) was the last team that we lost to, but for preparation and different things like that, there's definitely not a revenge factor. The game of football is much more complex than that and it takes more than just revenge to beat a team like Coldwater."

ODDS ARE: When asked what the betting line of Mooney throwing more passes than Coldwater would be should Vegas post it, Fecko didn't hesitate to answer.

"I wouldn't take that bet," Fecko chuckled. "That wouldn't even be on the board."

TRADITION: Both Coldwater and Mooney have storied traditions.

The Cardinals are making their ninth appearance in the state finals and looking for their seventh title. Mooney has been in the playoffs 21 times.

Coldwater is making its fourth appearance in the state finals and has a string of 11 straight postseason appearances, which ranks third best right now in the state behind only Cleveland St. Ignatius (20 straight) and Columbus DeSales (14 straight). Newark Catholic has also been in the playoffs 11 straight years.
