Coldwater Outlasts Kenton in Marathon Matchup

The 2009 football campaign began on a cloudy sprinkle-filled evening at Cavalier Stadium and saw the Coldwater Cavaliers trade punches with the Kenton Wildcats before a packed house of enthusiastic fans.

The game took over three hours to complete but in the end Coldwater finally prevailed by scoring the go-ahead touchdown in the last 90 seconds of the game.

If one thought that the weather might extend the evening as it has a few times in recent memory, they'd be wrong. The game took so long because both team feature the pass. In fact they threw a combined 96 passes. And 21 penalties extended the evening as well.

Coldwater wasted no time as they scored the first 22 points of the game. It had the look of recent Kenton matchups until Kenton took control of the game scoring midway through the second quarter to set the score at 22-6.

After the break Kenton continued to controlled the tempo and scored 20 unanswered points to take a 26-22 with eight minutes to play.

The teams continued to battle until Coldwater scored with 1:26 remaining to win the game 29-26.

Senior quarterback Keith Wenning was 22-34 for 239 yards and 3 touchdowns while rushing 23 times for 65 yards. Kurt Schoenheer lead the receiver corps with 6 catches for 76 yards and two TDs.

For Kenton, super sophomore Maty Mauk was 35-56 for 345 yards and three TDs. Andrew Tillman lead all receivers with 117 yards and one TD covering 41 yards.

It was the eighth straight win for the Cavaliers over the Wildcats. The Cavs lead the series 17-9.

Week 2 Features First Ever Meeting With Benjamin Logan High School

Next week, Coldwater completes the non-league portion of their schedule with a first ever trip to Logan Counties' Benjamin Logan High School for a match up with the Raiders.

Ben Logan is coming of a 3-7 season as members of the Central Buckeye Conference. The Raiders moved up to Division III this season.

In their opener they lost a close game to Riverside 14-13. The Raiders led 13-0 at half time but could not hold off Riverside who won their first opener in four years.

For the Raiders, Landon McKirahan rushing was 8-58 and Jonathan Mobley had 55 yards on 13 carries. Dustin Bowers added 43 yards on the ground.

Historically, Coldwater is 50-18-5 and 12-2 under Coach Reed in week two action. Cavalier fans will recall week 2 in 2007 when the Marion Local Flyers drop Coldwater by a score of 35-14 for their only loss in a season that saw the Cavaliers win their second state title.
