Cavaliers Have No Trouble with New Bremen

The Coldwater Cavaliers got off to a fast start despite a light rain driven by 20-30 mph winds as they defeated the New Bremen Cardinals 47-6 in the final game of the regular season.

The victory leaves Coldwater with a 7-1 MAC record and coupled with Anna's loss to Marion Local gave the Cavs sole possession of second place as Delphos won the MAC title. Coldwater finished the regular season at 9-1.

Coldwater was led again by senior quarterback Keith Wenning who rushed for 46 yards on 6 carries and threw the football 13 times, completing 9 for 123 yards and two touchdowns.

Kurt Westerheide stated the scoring in the first quarter snagging a 7 yard pass from Wenning. On the ensuing kickoff, New Bremen had trouble handing the slippery pigskin and it squirted into the end zone where Reese Klenke recovered it for Coldwater's second touchdown in 10 seconds of play.

Jacob Pohl scored on a 20 yard scamper to close out the first quarter with Coldwater leading 20-0.

Coldwater To Host Playoff Game

The Coldwater Cavaliers finished the 2009 as second place finishers in Region 20 of the Division 5 computer rankings. This earns them the right to host a first round playoff game against the number 7 team, the Rams of Hamilton Badin.

These teams have met once before in week 13 of the 2001 playoffs, a game Coldwater won 23-3. the playoffs. This is Badin's 17th playoff appearance

Badin is a member of the Greater Catholic League and their opponents are mostly D3 and D4

In the second Aaron Rammel scored on a 1 yard run and later Brady Otten intercepted a pass and ran it back 38 yards for another score and things were quickly getting out of hand for the Cardinals.

Coldwater closed out the second quarter with two more scores as Wenning found Adam Rammel for a 39 yard score and brother Aaron scored on a 13 yard run to set the halftime score at 47-0.

In the second half, Coldwater played their second team and the defensive unit did a good job of holding New Bremen in check. But with 1:37 remaining in the third quarter, the Cardinal's best player, Spencer Rohr broke loose around the right end and 78 yards later blew up the Cavalier bid for a second shut-out in as many weeks. Rohr lead all rushers carrying the ball 27 times for 140 yards. Rohr established himself as New Bremen's all time rushing leader.

It was another solid win for the Cavaliers and now they can turn their attention to the playoffs.

This season marks the Cavaliers 13th consecutive playoff appearance and 15th overall. Coldwater owns four regional championships and two state runner up trophies. In 2005 and 2007 the Cavaliers won the D4 state title.

The MAC is sending five teams into the playoffs this year. Anna, Delphos, St. Henry and Marion Local join Coldwater in this years quest for state title glory.
