Coldwater Too Much For The Young Raiders

Coldwater's longest road trip for the 2009 regular season was a pleasant one as the Cavaliers had little trouble with the Benjamin Logan Raiders winning 41-7.

Senior signal caller Keith Wenning led the Cavs once again this week going 14 of 18 for 232 yards and three touchdowns. He added a fourth score on a 1 yard plunge. His passes were spread between six receivers including Colin Paynter (5-132), Kurt Schoenherr (3-36) and Andre Feltz (2-41).

Kurt Westerheide led all rushers on the evening netting 44 yards on just three carries and Ross Wermert provided the short yardage scoring 2 touchdowns on 4 rushes for nine total yards.

The Cavalier defense had a good evening as they held the Raider offense led by QB Dustin Bowers to just 11 yards of total offense in the first half and 80 total yards for the night. The defensive pressure also forced seven Raider fumbles,

two of which the Cavs recovered.

The Raiders were definitely outmatched in this contest but give them credit as they fought hard for all four quarters. Bowers was helped off the field early in the first quarter after a shot to his knee and on the next series was doubled over backwards when he was sacked in the Raider backfield. But give the youngster credit. He as valiant in leading his charges against the superior talent from Coldwater. The Raiders finally cracked the scoreboard with five minutes left in the game for their only score.
