Cavaliers Start Fast Then Hang Tough

Coldwater scored on their first two offensive plays and then fought tooth and nail the rest of the way to hold off a much improved Versailles Tigers squad 25-14.

Kurt Westerheide scored on a 24 yard scamper on the Cavs first play from scrimmage and Keith Wenning executed a quarterback draw for 75 yards on their next play just three minutes later to put the Tigers in a 12-0 hole with six minutes gone in the first quarter.

Wenning had is best game as a varsity starter with 296

yards of total offense. Keith was 17 of 25 passing for 176 yards and one touchdown while netting 120 yards on 17 carries.

Colin Paynter had six catches and Kurt Schoenheer grabbed five passes. Reese Klenke made his first start since breaking a collar bone in the preseason catching three passes including a 39 yard touchdown pass. Aaron Rammel tallied Coldwater's last touchdown on a 12 yard run in the third.

The Tigers are a much improved team in their sec-

ond season running the spread offense. QB Derek Langenkamp as he was in on all but one of Versailles offensive plays as he ran the ball 25 times and threw a total of 47 passes, completing 25 for 227 yards and 2 touchdowns including a 40 yarder to Mitchell Campbell.

Both teams combined for 656 yards of total offense.
