## MAC Completes Week 1 at 8-2

The Midwest Athletic Conference started off the 2019 campaign in a big way winning 8 of the 10 games played against non-conference opponents. Versailles lost a heartbreaker to Celina by one point while Covington travelled to St. Henry and defeated the Redskins on the strength of 3 special teams touchdowns (blocked field goal, blocked punt and a kick off return)

New Bremen was the surprise of the week. Not because they won; the Cardinals are a much improved team, but because they travelled to Ada and hung 51 points on the Bulldogs.

Parkway defeated Crestview, a team that reached the regional finals last season, by a score of 33-20. St. Johns was one point better than Elida 28-27.

Teams expected to finish in the top half of the conference, Anna, Coldwater, Ft. Recovery, Marion Local and Minster all posted big wins.

Next week the search for non-conference computer points continues with some teams facing some big opponents including, Anna at Brookville, Fort at Valley View, Marion Local goes to Columbus to visit Watterson. Can Covington pull another upset as they host Minster? The Parkway at Spencerville matchup should be intriguing. St. Henry will try to rebound at Ft. Loramie while St. Johns will host LCC on Saturday night.

## Next Week: Mt. Healthy

This will be the first ever meeting between the Cavaliers and the Fighting Owls who hail from the Southwest Ohio Conference. This game will be played in Cincinnati. Next season the Owls will visit Mercer County.

Last season they were 5-6 and lost to Alter in the opening round of the playoffs.
