The Week in the MAC

After a weekend of upsets that resulted in four teams occupying the top spot in the MAC with just two games to play, there were no surprises in Week 9 so the standings remain unchanged. Anna, Coldwater, Minster and Marion Local all held serve and won their games handily.

The final week of the season will see one game that always draws interest from all over the state of Ohio. Coldwater will visit Marion Local with a piece of the MAC title on the line. These two teams have won more games since 2000 than any other program in the OHSAA. Coldwater (242-36) is currently just 8 games better than the Flyers (234-43) who have nine state titles to the Cavaliers six.

The past 10 seasons have seen these teams meet 12 times. The past two seasons the Flyers played in Division 6 along with the Cavaliers and they met in the last two Regional Finals. They Flyers won both of those games.

Oh, and of course, there is one other facet to this game. Some people want to know that outcome more than the final score. "How much was the 50-50 worth?" In the last four meetings the average take has been \$11,000.

Finally, traditionally in the MAC the coach of the year award goes to the coach of the MAC champion. With the title probably being shared by three teams this season, there exists the chance give it to a truly deserving coach. If I had a vote it would go to New Bremen's Chris Schmidt. It was just a few years ago that the New Bremen school board was wrestling with the question of shutting down the football program due to lack of numbers. This season Coach Schmidt has the Cardinals in position to make the playoffs. And if they can pull off a victory this Friday against visiting rival Minster, they would actually host a playoff game. Win or lose on Friday, Coach Schmidt has earned COY honors.

Next Week: Marion Local

Once again a game between the two most successfully high school programs in the OHSAA will decide who reigns at the top of the MAC. The Coldwater Cavaliers visits Booster Field in Maria Stein to face the Marion Local Flyers.

It will more than likely be a shared title as Anna and Minster share the lead with the Cavs and Flyers. They are expected to win their matchups so we should see the first three-way tie for championship since 1989 when Minster, Delphos and St. Henry share the top spot.
